REGISTRAR'S REPORT

I have now been in the role of Registrar for some 18 months and have enjoyed what has been a very busy year. A significant amount of work was generated by the success of the Amnesty this year, which resulted in 64 ponies being returned to the Stud Book. While many of these ponies were late foal notifications, a number of ponies had identities confirmed by DNA parentage verification and have been returned as older adults. Sadly, there were several ponies that could not be identified and this is always disappointing. The laboratory staff at the Equine Genetic Research Centre (EGRC) have been extremely helpful and professional going above and beyond. Knowledge of long-term members and Vicki's extensive experience in the role also greatly assisted in tracking down potential leads. Covid restrictions have resulted in some time delays including postage, some of which never arrived at all! Thank you for everyone's patience.

The electronic Stud Book has been operating consistently for the most part. There was one major platform outage that resulted in anomalies arising in ownership details for several ponies. These have been rectified to the best of my knowledge, however as always, if members see a record that looks to be incorrect, please advise me. I think for all of us who work with technology, this is part of working with even the most sophisticated of systems. SAMMS completes regular backups and the Society also keeps paper records. Updates to information such as whorls, historic transfers and HWSD results that did not transfer across to the new system due to data incompatibility, continue to be checked and added as time permits.

I have included updated statistics that build on the numbers from last year's report to assist in gauging the status of the national herd over time. Details of individual births and transfers will be provided in the next e-bulletin.

Similar to last year, it is worthwhile again cautioning against any definitive trends due to the 'sample' size. Of note however are the updated birth notifications for 2018 and 2019. These are a result of the Amnesty and do point to the likely

impact of the of the last drought and devastating fires across several states on birth numbers generally as well as delays in submitting birth notifications. The Amnesty is only held every 5 to 6 years and provides an opportunity for lost ponies to be returned to the Stud Book as well as being one way the Society can support members in times of difficulty, balanced against financial capacity and membership expectations.

The decline in birth numbers continued into 2020, however indications for 2021 based on submission of stallion returns, is that there is likely to be an increase in foaling rates. This possibly reflects a response to lack of supply to meet the current demand, as well as an improvement in environmental conditions with wide spread rain across much of Australia, although noting that there are still some parts of the country in drought.

The impact of Covid is hard to gauge with financial distress through job and income loss impacting stud activities for some members, while lockdowns have conversely seen increased time available at home resulting in renewed interest in activities outside work. Certainly, the inability to travel has necessitated the reliance on technology to continue stud activities, particularly sales, with many ponies being purchased sight unseen. Fortunately, the continued operation of the horse transports has enabled ponies to move across borders, if not their owners!

My personal observation is that we are seeing high demand for pure bred and part bred ponies, with some ponies selling before public advertisement, and those listed selling quickly. I am aware that studs are receiving regular queries and even have a waiting list. The FB sites suggest ongoing interest in ponies listed for sale and seeking to purchase. Quality pure bred mares appear particularly to be in demand. Again, my personal observation for this high demand relates to a decline in breeding in the last few years combined with ongoing and increased recognition and interest in the Connemara as a versatile all-rounder, capable of high-level performance across a range of disciplines and a convivial family pony

for children and adults. The transfer rates for this year reflect the increased activity and are double that of last year with 85 to 5 October 2021 compared to 41 at 25 September last year. (Individual transfers will be provided in the next e-bulletin).

Purebred adult registrations have also increased this year with 35 recorded to date. This includes four ponies successful at inspection for entry into Class 1. The largest increase has been in the Class 2 mares (nearly doubling). There has been an increase in Class 3 entries, although in the majority of cases I have been advised that owners are proposing to arrange a veterinary inspection

for Class 2 entry. I encourage members to ensure their breeding ponies are Class 2 registered at a minimum. The pure-bred progeny of Class 3 ponies have limited class eligibility.

I thank everyone for their patience and support during the year, and would again like to mention Vicki and Bob Plummer who continue to provide unfailing advice and assistance.

I look forward to a bright foaling season ahead!

For Consideration of Election to the Position of President
of the Connemara Pony Breeders' Society Inc.

My name is Di Watt and I have had the privilege of owning Connemara's since 2008. As such, I am very much a newbie to the Connemara world and recognise the world of knowledge across this country that walks ahead, besides, and behind me. I was drawn to the Connemara pony after walking in the Connemara National Park in 2007 and coming across their breeding program. From there my interest has resulted in several lovely mares grazing my hills, with offspring born under the Dunmurry Prefix (from Dunmurry Kildare, my Irish ancestral country).

My family background with horses has generally related to their use as working animals, which ironically is exactly where the roots of the Connemara pony lie. I have attended the odd Pony Club camp, chased cattle and sheep, played a bit of polocrosse, and spent some time in my youth droving. After completing tertiary training in Agricultural Science and Animal Breeding I spent some valuable time at a leading equine veterinary practice assisting with surgical operations and post-operative care, completing blood pathologies and workups, and semen quality checks. I have assisted with our own cattle and merino breeding programs for the last decades.

I am a doctoral level psychologist (with a thesis exploring personality) which I believe allows me a high level of objectivity and enhanced ability to listen to both committee

persons and the membership. I have already raised some interest in doing some research to allow the committee to hear the voice of the membership both regarding the positives and the less than positives. I would be very open to learning of the concerns that members wished to raise. I freely recognise that I do not have the incredible knowledge of the bloodlines of our Connemara that others have, but I know how to ask questions!

I do have a very sound working knowledge of the simple Mendelian genetics behind the transmission of Hoof Wall Separation Disorder (HWSD; one of the most recent challenges for our pony across the world) and understand that it is better to educate than berate. I similarly see that genetic diversity in any small, closed population is critical.

I believe that you don't have to be the best eventer, dressage rider, or competitor to do a valuable job on a committee, just be admiring of their skills. I appreciate that being on a committee can be a juggling act and at times can be a balance of tensions and for that I thank those who have been and continue to be committee members of our society. I would be very honoured if it was seen appropriate for our membership to elect myself as the president of our society.

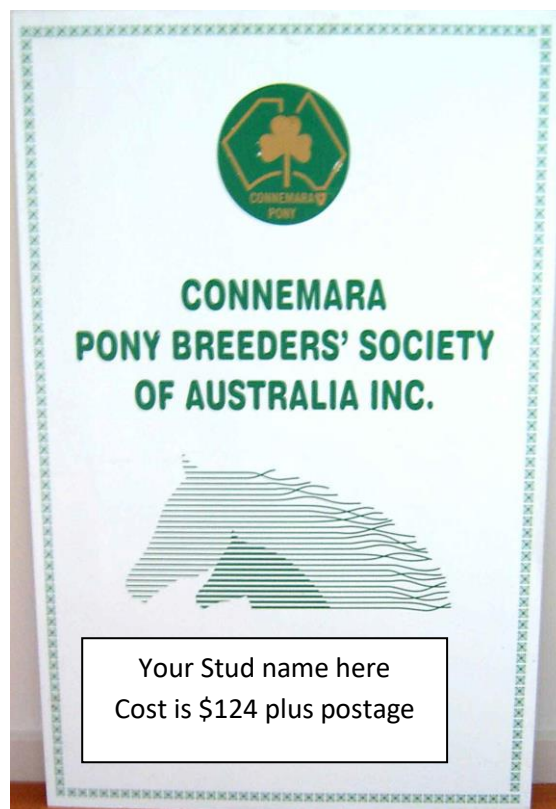

(e) **Embryo Transfer**

- i. Approval will not be granted for any filly under the age of 24 months.
- ii. Approval for a donor mare shall not be granted until such time as the CPBSA is in receipt of test results for HWSD.
- iii. The DNA analysis of both the stallion to be used to impregnate the donor mare and the donor mare must be on record with the CPBSA for each stallion and donor mare prior to any approval being granted.
- iv. Lessees of mares shall not be entitled to perform embryo transfer or freeze embryos for use with the CPBSA unless consent for such storage has been received by the CPBSA from the lessor in writing.
- v. In the event that the owner or lessee of the donor mare sells the embryo prior to birth an Embryo Sale form must be completed and such Embryo Sale form shall accompany the Birth Notification of the resulting foal.
- vi. In the event that the owner of the donor mare sells the mare prior to the birth of the embryo an Embryo Ownership form must be completed and such Embryo Ownership form shall accompany the Birth Notification of the resulting foal.
- vii. Any foal eligible for registration in the CPBSA Stud Book resulting from embryo transfer shall be DNA parentage verified within 180 days of the foal's birth.

g) Cloning

Due to the pandemic situation our perspectives and priorities have changed and the ICCPS work had been partly put on hold during 2020-2021. The challenges for professional and family business as well as breeding societies have been tough all over the world.

The Spring Festival and Show Week in Clifden 2021 were cancelled for a second year, like many Pony Shows worldwide. Pony inspections were held without audience. Society meetings & judges' conferences have been carried out on internet.

The ICCPS Executive Board (EB) has managed to keep the basic work running by phone and zoom conferences. In the extraordinary circumstances prevailing due to the pandemic, the EB agreed the ICCPS AGM 2020 should be postponed and that the EB would continue as it is until the AGM 2021. The 2020 Michael O'Malley Award was awarded Blanche Miller and will be presented to Blanche at the BCPS AGM in November 2021. In October Bob Plummer, Australia, took on the work with ICCPS web site.
